

ADULT SEWING CLASSES TO BEGIN

Waiialua Community Association is offering Adult Sewing Classes - Perfect for Beginners and those who want to brush up on their sewing skills. Learn basic sewing skills, sewing machine basics and sewing techniques. You can choose to use one of the sewing machines in class or you are welcome to bring your own if you'd like to learn how to use it. Class is small group and individual attention is available to each participant.



Participants must be Waiialua Community Association Members. Application for membership can be found on the WCA website: waiialuacommunityassociation.org or from the WCA office between 9:00 AM and 2:00 PM.

All participants must sign a waiver form and pay a fee of \$20 for a two-day session.

What you will learn:

1. How to properly thread machine and wind a bobbin.
2. How to sew straight seams and how to finish them
3. How to follow basic pattern instructions from cutting fabric to completion of project.
4. Learn the various functions and stitches of sewing machine.
5. Learn basic sewing machine maintenance to keep your machine in perfect running condition and how to trouble shoot and solve machine problems when they happen.

Materials will be provided for your first project which will be a reusable tote bag. You will need to bring your own scissors.

Session 1: Tuesday 7-9PM April 9 and 16

Session 2: Friday 10AM-12noon April 12 and 19

Maximum number of 6 participants per session.

Intermediate and advance classes will added and scheduled as participants move on to more challenging sewing projects.
