

PU‘UIKI BEACH PARK: CAMPER CODE OF CONDUCT

Preserving the Beauty of Waialua Through Responsible Stewardship

Welcome to Pu‘uiki. By camping here, you agree to protect our coastline and respect your fellow campers. Please ensure every member of your group is familiar with the following policies.

I. URGENT: SERVICE ADVISORY

- **No Facilities:** Until all repairs are complete, on-site restrooms and showers are closed.
- **No Potable Water:** There is currently no potable drinking water available at the park.
- **Camper Requirement:** All campers must provide their own portable toilet systems and a sufficient supply of fresh water for drinking, cooking, and hygiene. Disposal of human waste in the brush or ocean is strictly prohibited and will result in immediate removal.

II. SITE LIMITS & CAPACITY

- **Maximum Occupancy:** 10 people per campsite.
- **Dimensions:** Your setup must remain within the designated 30' x 30' area.
- **Equipment:** Max of 3 tents and 1 canopy per site. Tents must be ground-based (no car/truck-bed camping).
- **Duration:** Maximum stay is 5 consecutive days.

III. THE "PACK IN, PACK OUT" RULE

- **Zero Trash Policy:** There is no rubbish collection at this park.
- **Responsibility:** All trash, food scraps, and recycling **must be removed from the park** by the campers.
- **Impact:** Leaving bags near park bins or in the brush is considered littering and is subject to fines.

IV. NOISE & COMMUNITY RESPECT

- **Quiet Hours: 9:00 PM to 7:00 AM.** * **Courtesy:** Outside of quiet hours, keep music and voices at a level that does not travel beyond your 30' x 30' boundary.
- **Amplification:** Large professional speakers or PA systems are strictly prohibited.

V. FIRE, COOKING & TREES

- **No Ground Fires:** Bonfires or fires in the sand are illegal and dangerous.
- **Grills:** Use only elevated charcoal grills or gas stoves.
- **Coals:** Never bury hot coals in the sand or dump them near trees. Extinguish and pack them out or use designated bins if available.
- **Trees:** Do not cut, saw, or damage trees (including Ironwoods). Do not hang hammocks or heavy gear from branches.

VI. VEHICLES & PARKING

- **Permits:** Display your printed permit on the driver-side dashboard.
- **Parking:** Stay in designated stalls. Driving on the grass or sand is strictly prohibited.
- **Gates:** Observe all posted gate hours. Vehicles remaining after-hours may be locked in until morning.

VII. SAFETY & ENVIRONMENT

- **CRB Quarantine:** Pu'uiki is a Coconut Rhinoceros Beetle zone. Do not move green waste (logs, mulch, chips) out of the Waialua area.
- **Wildlife:** Do not feed stray animals or birds. Keep all food in hard-sided containers.
- **Prohibited:** Alcohol and pets are not permitted in the park except for _____.
